The Challenge: **Circle One**

Option 1: Complete 1 ride at each of the 3 rides below, on the same horse, any distance (excluding intro rides). You may switch distances during the challenge but must be on the same horse.

Option 2: You may complete the Pioneer at Lone Star Express or Llano Estacado on the same horse LD or Endurance. Pioneer means same horse same distance.

Option 3: You may do your first 50, 75 or 100 ever as a rider! We would like to encourage those of you who have not tried endurance to take the plunge. If you complete your first 50, 75 or 100 then you will have completed the challenge! Please circle the ride you plan to do your 50, 75 or 100 at or let me know before you begin if you are not sure which one you are planning on riding. I must know before you start that you are in the Mortl Challenge for that ride.
